

# **Priscilla Fox Pfizenmayer Communication Arts Scholarship**

**The Priscilla Fox Pfizenmayer Communication Arts Scholarship is presented annually to a student seeking a career in Communication Arts. Examples of related work demonstrating the applicant's strengths in the application and performance of communication arts must be submitted with the application.**

Established by Priscilla Fox Pfizenmayer, who graduated from DCCC in 1981 and credits the College “with the impetus that led her to a career in communications”, this **\$500 scholarship** will benefit a student who meets the following criteria:

1. Seeking a career in Communication Arts
2. Completed 24 credits at DCCC with a minimum 3.0 grade point average
3. Demonstrated ability in the application and performance of communication competencies – such as in radio, drama, writing for publication or public speaking – written, audio or video materials.
  - spoken successfully before civic, church, or professional groups
  - taken part in “Readers Theater” or other type of dramatic performance at DCCC or elsewhere
  - successfully published a poem, work or prose or news article in a college, professional, or civic publication
  - hosted own show on campus radio or community radio/cable TV
  - organized a charitable drive or community effort marked by public speaking and/or entertaining, on or off campus
  - served an internship or had work experience in communication field
4. Demonstrated financial need, as described in the application statement and/or determined by the Director of Financial Aid.
