## **DUAL ADMISSION TRANSFER AGREEMENT**

### **Advantages of the Agreement**

- **Guaranteed admission** to the Women's College, providing all requirements are met.
- **Junior year status** with the completion of 54 or more credits.
- **Academic scholarships and/or grants** for those who qualify.
- **Waiver of application fee.**
- **Access to an Immaculata Library card**, if requested.
- **Invitation to informational advising meetings** with Immaculata University faculty and staff.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Submit the “**Intent to Enroll**” form **before** completing 30 transferable credits, including courses from other colleges and universities.
- Complete any AA or AS Degree with a minimum 2.0 Final Grade Point Average (GPA).
- Enroll at Immaculata (Women's College) as a full-time student within one year of graduating from DCCC.
- Satisfy all other Immaculata admission requirements.

### **Transfer Requirements**

- Meet with a DCCC transfer counselor to complete an “**Intent to Enroll**” form.
- Submit an Immaculata University Application after the completion of 45 credits or three to six months prior to transferring.
- Apply for graduation and forward a **final transcript** reflecting the degree earned and the final Grade Point Average (GPA).
