



DUAL ADMISSIONS AGREEMENT

Peirce College and Delaware County Community College

Peirce College welcomes transfer applicants from both two-year and four-year colleges around the country and the world. We know that as a prospective transfer student, you have special needs and concerns. Peirce College's Dual Admissions and Program-to-Program transfer agreements were designed to facilitate students' ease of transfer into any of Peirce's undergraduate majors and, ultimately, to foster academic success.

ADVANTAGES OF THE DUAL ADMISSIONS PROGRAM

If you are newly admitted to an associate's degree program or have earned 30 or fewer college-level transferable credits, you are eligible to complete an INTENT TO ENROLL FORM available in the Division of Educational Support Services, W1-1.

Please note: students who have previously been matriculated to Peirce College are not eligible for the Dual Admissions program.

Registration in this program entitles you to be admitted into a bachelor's degree program at Peirce provided that you: earn your associate's degree, A. A., A. S. or A.A.S., with a minimum 2.5 final grade point average; enroll at Peirce within one calendar year of graduation from Delaware County Community College; and do not attend another institution between graduation from Delaware County Community College and enrollment at Peirce. (Your enrollment is non-binding and can be canceled if you send written notification to both Peirce College and Delaware County Community College.) The program offers these distinct advantages:

* **Substantial scholarship opportunities** for great students!

Full-time: \$1,000 academic scholarship to students with final 3.0-3.49 GPA;
\$2,000 academic scholarship to students with final 3.5-4.0 GPA;
awards may be renewed up to four years, in addition to any federal, state or Peirce need-based aid for which they qualify.

Part-time*: \$500 academic scholarship to transfer students with final 3.0-3.49 GPA; and
\$1,000 academic scholarship to students with final 3.5-4.0 GPA; both awards may be renewed up to four years.

*registered with fewer than 12 Peirce credits per semester.

- * **\$50 application fee waiver** to Peirce College, less paperwork, no wait for a decision!
- * **Invitations to meet faculty** and Program Advisor at preview events offered at Peirce College.
- * **Access to Peirce educational facilities**, including the library and computer labs. A Peirce College student identification card will be provided.
- * **ESL students who earn an associate's degree** and successfully complete English Composition will not need to take the TOEFL exam.

You must complete a "DUAL ADMISSIONS INTENT" form, which may be obtained in the Career and Counseling Center at Delaware County Community College. For additional information, ask any counselor or call Peirce College Admission at (215) 670-9214.

DEADLINE: This is a limited-time opportunity for continuing students with 0-30 college-level credits. Visit the Career and Counseling Center to sign up now!

5 EASY STEPS TO DUAL ADMISSION:

1. Visit the Career and Counseling Center at DCCC to fill out an “Intent to Enroll” form BEFORE completing 30 college credits. Admissions staff will pre-screen you to make sure you are eligible for the program.
2. Within the semester you are accepted into the Dual Admissions Program, you will receive a CONDITIONAL ADMIT letter from Peirce College.
3. In the semester BEFORE you are planning to begin attending Peirce College, you must pick up a Dual Admissions Information Form from the Career and Counseling Center at Delaware County Community College. This form should be sent to Peirce along with your official Delaware County Community College transcript by JUNE 1st for fall admission or NOVEMBER 1st for spring admission.
4. Request OFFICAL TRANSCRIPTS from any other college you have attended, as well as from your high school.
5. To be considered for a Dual Admission Scholarship, a FINAL TRANSCRIPT reflecting degree earned and final grade point average must be sent from Delaware County Community College to the Admissions Office at Peirce College.

ABOUT PEIRCE’S NEW Program-to-Program TRANSFER AGREEMENT

You can also take advantage of Peirce’s new “transfer-friendly” Program-to-Program agreement that eliminates obstacles for Delaware County Community College graduates who want to pursue a bachelor’s degree at Peirce.

The Program-to-Program Transfer agreement allows students entering Peirce from Delaware County Community College with an Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in Accounting, Business Management, Business Technology, Computer Programming, Paralegal Studies, or Network Engineering or an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree in Business Administration to meet most degree program requirements for Peirce’s Bachelor of Science degree.

This agreement does not change the applicability of transferred courses or programs to Peirce’s major requirements.

Potential transfer students from DCCC should consult their transfer counselors about these requirements. Other transfer students should consult Peirce publications or discuss the matter with an admissions counselor or Program Advisor.
