Praxis I and II Test Preparation

The Praxis Series is an Educational Testing Service (ETS) program that provides tests and other services for states to use as part of the teacher certification process. In Pennsylvania, **all candidates for certification must successfully complete the three-part Praxis I Exam: Pre-Professional Skills Test.**

The **Praxis I: Math** and the **Praxis I: Reading/Writing** refresh the math, reading and writing skills needed to pass the PPST mentioned above.

The **Praxis II: Fundamental Subjects** course reviews the language arts, math, social science, and science topics covered in Praxis Test 0511.

The **Praxis II: Elementary Education** course covers reading/language arts, math, science, social studies, fine arts and physical education topics covered in Praxis Test 0011.

Candidates for Early Childhood, Elementary, Special Education and K-12 subject areas must also pass the Praxis II Fundamental Subjects: Content Knowledge Test.

Prospective and new teachers of students in elementary grades must also pass the Praxis II Elementary Education: Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment exam.
