



Nonprofit Fundraising Certificate Program

WHO SHOULD CONSIDER THIS CERTIFICATION?

The Nonprofit Fundraising Certificate was developed for people looking for a change in career or for those who are already working or volunteering in the sector and would like to broaden their skills.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

The program requires successful completion of six core courses.

Courses

Fundraising for Nonprofits
Starting a Fundraising Program
Grant Writing and Research
Event Planning
Grant Writing II
Get Publicity with Press Releases

All classes may be used as part of the education requirement for Certified Fund Raising Executive (CFRE) designation offered by CFRE International. (CFRE is an advanced certification for fundraising sponsored by fourteen leading philanthropic associations, including the Association of Fundraising Professionals.) CFRE requires, among other things, 80 hours of education.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO EARN MY CERTIFICATE?

While the certificate can be completed in as little as one semester, there is no specific time period required for completion of the program.

ARE THERE EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR SKILLED FUNDRAISERS?

The nonprofit sector is one of the fastest growing segments of the US economy; the IRS recently reported that about 40,000 new nonprofits are formed each year. The growth in the sector has made fundraising more competitive than ever. As a result, knowledgeable and skilled fundraisers are in demand.
