Includes medical terminology, reading and interpreting prescriptions, and defining drugs by generic and brand names. Learn dosage calculations, IV flow rates, drug compounding and dose conversions. Physical Therapy Aide (CAR 3961)

The Physical Therapy Aide works under the direction of the physical therapist and is generally responsible for carrying out non-technical duties such as preparing treatment areas, ordering devices and supplies and transporting patients. They assist in providing services that help improve mobility, relieve pain, and prevent or limit permanent physical disabilities of patients suffering from injuries or disease.
