

2008 CCSSE Student Survey: All Survey Items Comparisons with all Three Norm Groups

The Community College Student Survey of Engagement (CCSSE) was administered during the Spring 2008 semester to a random sample of classes. Data were gathered on over 900 DCCC students. The student profile is similar to the profile for the entire DCCC student population, except for enrollment status. Survey respondents were more predominantly full time, due to the CCSSE sampling procedure. CCSSE analyses weight the data to account for the overrepresentation of full time students. This report shows items on which there were significant differences with any of the comparison groups.
