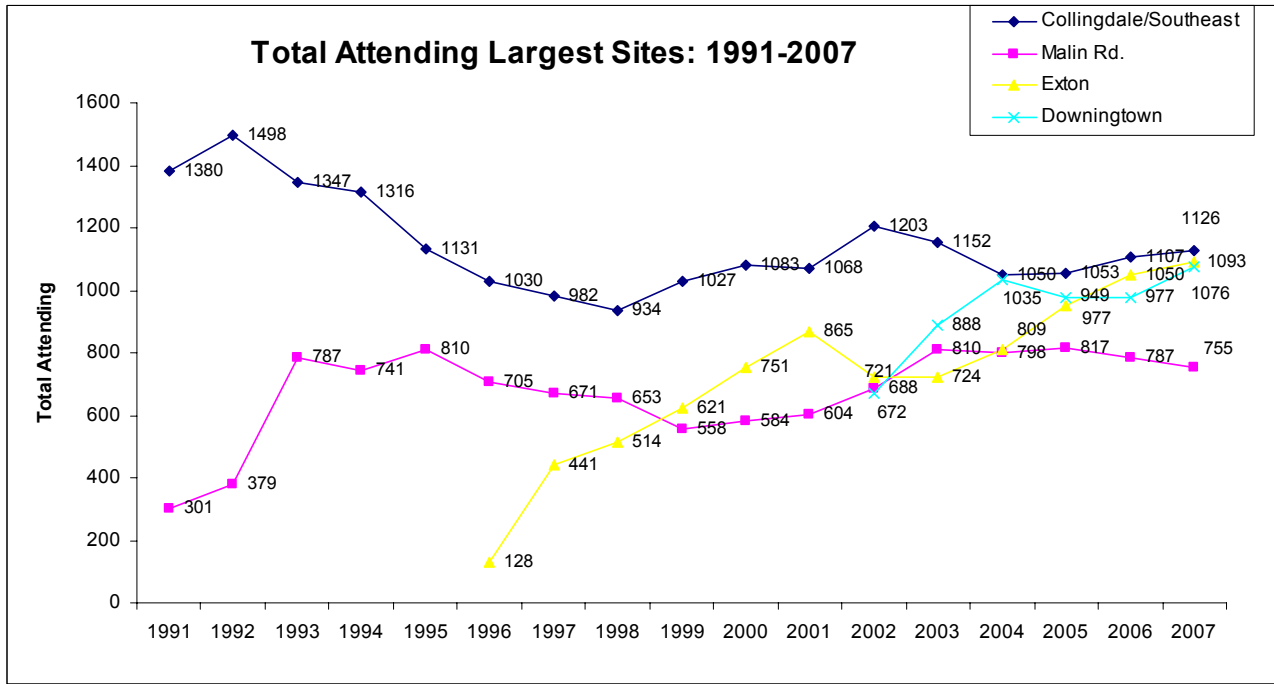

Profile of Off-Campus Students

Gender

- Off-campus students are evenly divided by gender.

Age

- The proportion of 15-24 year old students has increased. Younger students now represent almost two-thirds (60%) of the off-campus population. Increased enrollment at Exton and Downingtown contribute to this trend because Exton and Downingtown students are younger than students at other sites. Median age dropped to 22 years.

Race

- Black/African-American enrollment, which represented only 4% of the off-campus population in 1985, has risen to 19%.

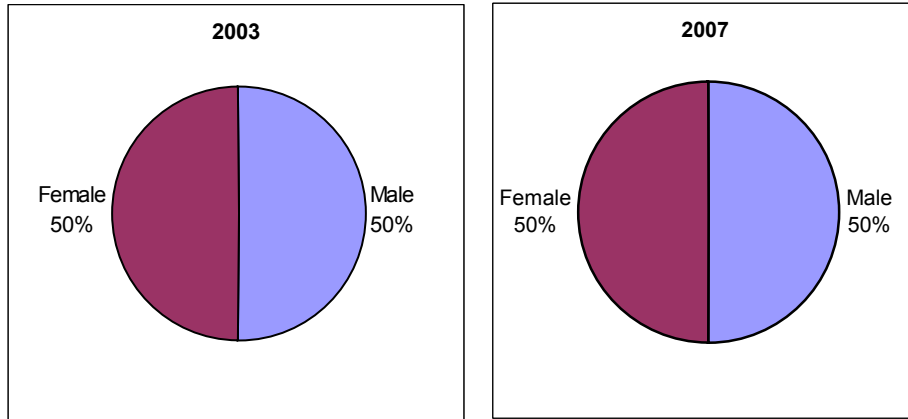
Residence

- The proportion of off-campus students who reside in Chester County increased from 8% in 1995 to 51% in 2007.

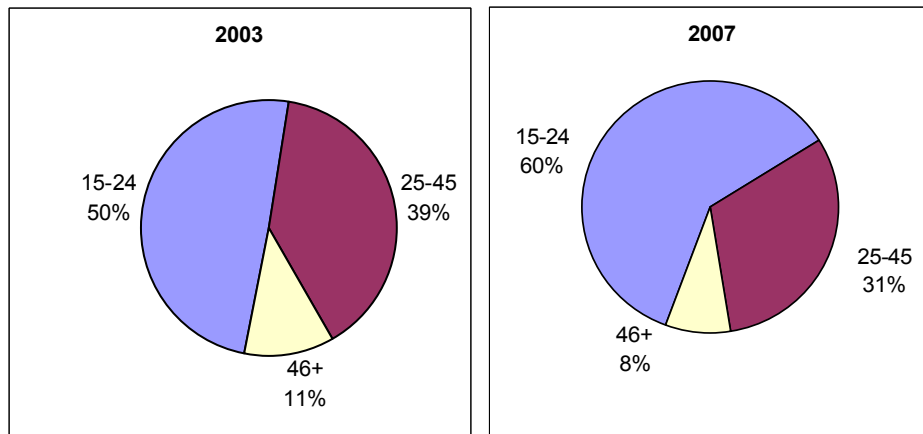
Student Majors

- Transfer majors represent half of all off-campus students.

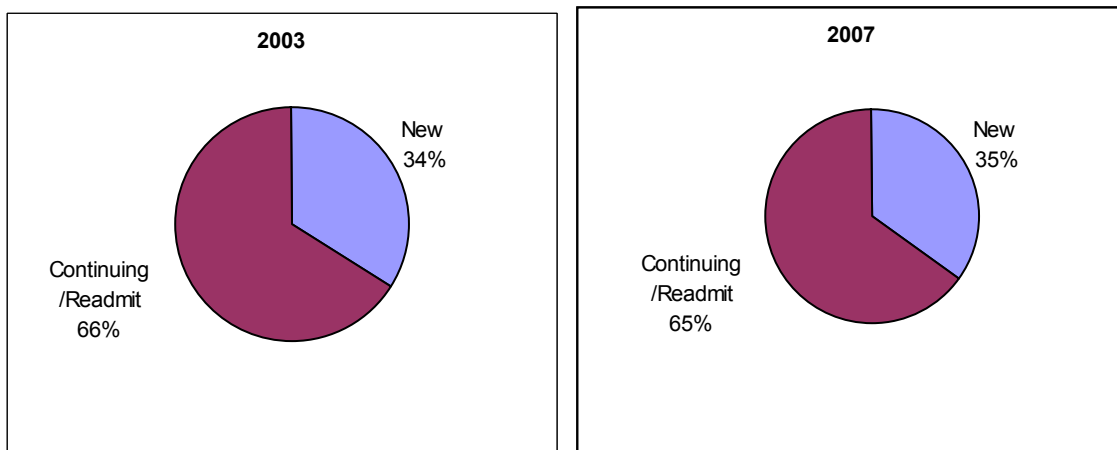

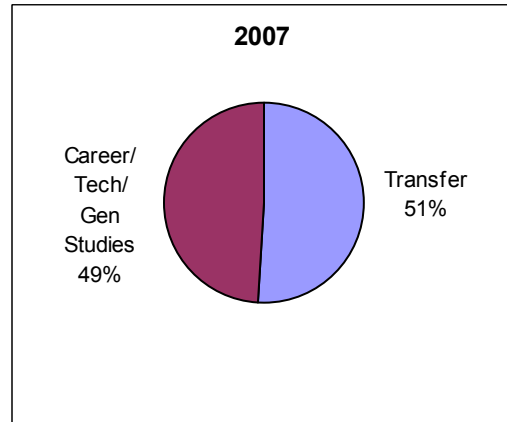
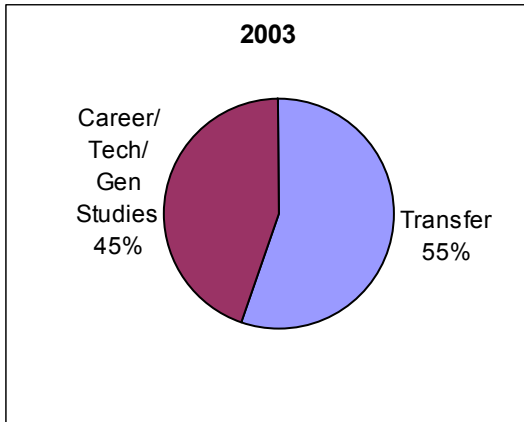
Age Category



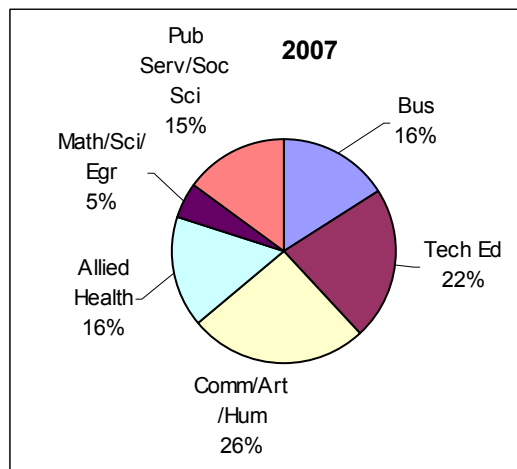
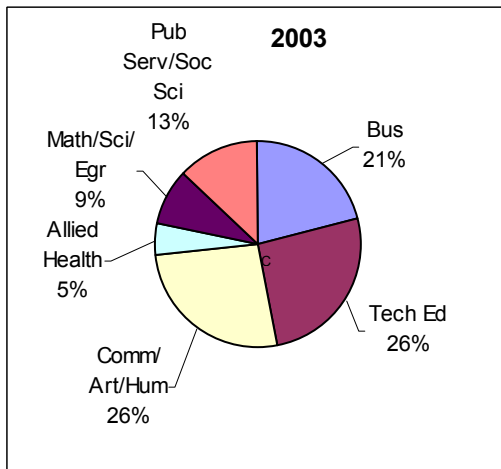
