### 2006 Reported Crime Statistics Contiguous Public Property 3 Year Comparision

**Contiguous Public Property is defined as *non-campus* buildings or *other public properties*:**

*Non-Campus* – A building or property owned/controlled by another institution and used in direct support of DCCC's educational purposes, is frequently used by students, and is not within the same reasonably contiguous geographic described above. Examples: Hospitals used for student clinical experiences and/or other training for students at a property not owned/controlled by DCCC (e.g. the Delco Emergency Services facility).

*Public Property*—"public property" is defined by the Clery Act regulations as all public property including thoroughfares, streets, sidewalks, and parking facilities that are within the campus, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus.
